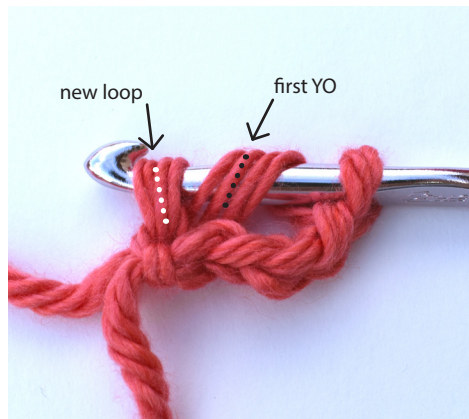


Foundation Double Crochet.....everytrickonthehook.com

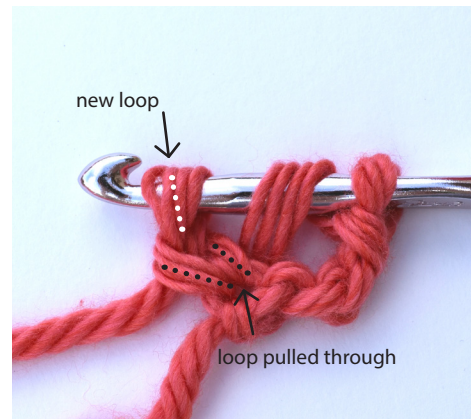
CHEAT SHEET



1. Ch4 {this counts as your first fdc, if you chain loosely try a ch3 here instead}.



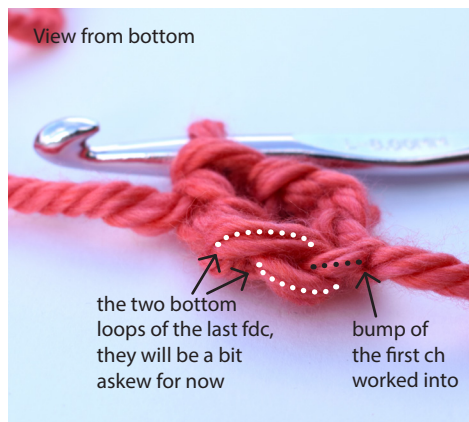
2. YO and insert your hook in the chain furthest from your hook {it doesn't matter which loops you grab, I usually grab just the back loop}, then YO and pull up a loop.



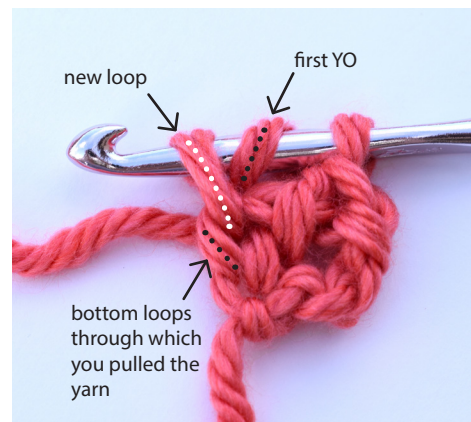
3. YO and pull through ONE loop on your hook {think of this as the ch1 that would normally be at the base of your dc}.



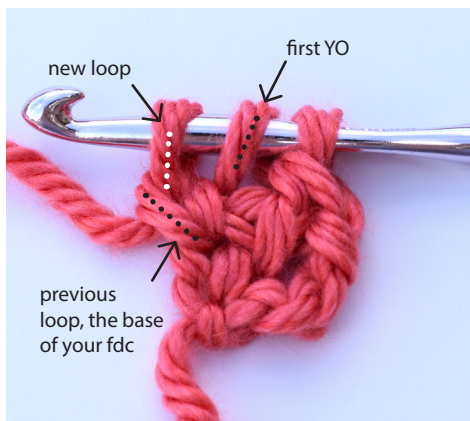
4. [YO and pull through 2 loops on hook] twice {think of this part as the dc, and ta-da! your second fdc is complete}.



5. Look at the bottom of the fdc that you just made and identify the two loops that look similar to the two loops at the top of a stitch.



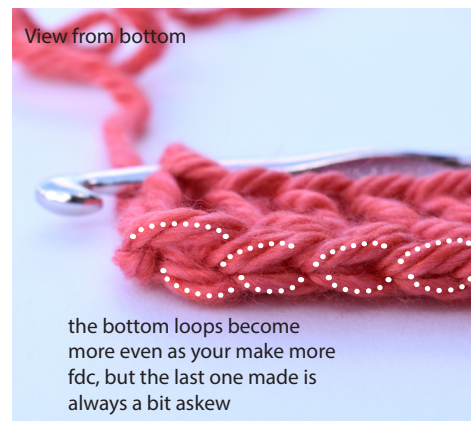
6. YO and insert your hook into those two loops, then YO and pull up a loop.



7. YO and pull through ONE loop on your hook {again, think of this as the ch1 at the base of your st}.



8. [YO and pull through 2 loops on hook] twice {again, think of this part as the dc}.



9. Repeat steps 5 through 8 until you have the desired number of fdc.
